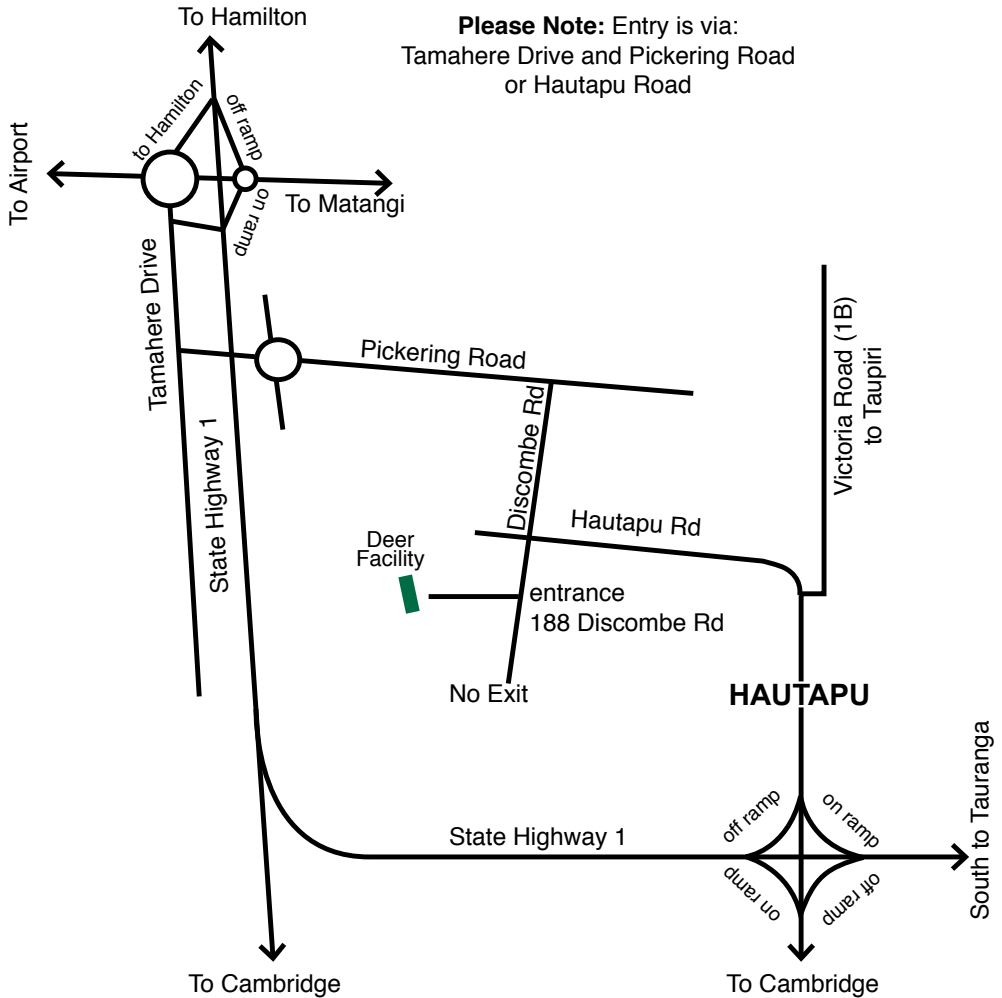

5. The sale will be conducted exclusive of GST.
6. **Disclaimer:** All details in this catalogue have been supplied to the Auctioneer by the vendor and although every care has been taken to ensure accuracy, the auctioneer and their employees do not accept any responsibility or liability as to mis-description, errors, omissions or mis-statements caused either directly or by the negligence of the auctioneer or their employees.

Hard Antler removal later will circumvent the risk of, for which we are not responsible, pedicle skin die back. **Unless we are advised that stags are to leave Tower Farms with their antlers on, the velvet will be removed the day after the sale, and retained by Tower Farms. All animals are to be transported before Christmas.** Note Sue Douglas will organise all transport.

Should a stag prove to be infertile from natural causes it will be replaced or a full credit given to use at a subsequent Tower Farms Deer Stag Sale, in this situation the stag in question is to be returned to the vendor. In all events the seller will not be held responsible for loss of production or consequential losses on any animal sold. Notification of any dissatisfaction must be made within 9 months of the date of sale.
