



- 2. As is customary all purchases will be the buyers property and risk from the fall of the hammer. Tower Farms takes all care but no responsibility for deer held prior to transporting to the purchaser, we recommend you insure your purchase.
- 3. Deer will be sold under individual Lot numbers as catalogued.
- 4. No deer are to leave the property until satisfactory payment arrangements have been made with the vendor.
- 5. The sale will be conducted exclusive of GST.
- 6. **Disclaimer:** All details in this catalogue have been supplied to the Auctioneer by the vendor and although every care has been taken to ensure accuracy, the auctioneer and their employees do not accept any responsibility or liability as to mis-description, errors, omissions or mis-statements caused either directly or by the negligence of the auctioneer or their employees.
- An over riding commission of 4% will be paid to non participating companies providing PRIOR ARRANGEMENTS (i.e. No later than 24 hours prior to sale day) are made with Joe or Sue. There are no exceptions to this rule!

- 9. We encourage stag purchasers to transport their stags with antlers on (transporters specialize in this). Hard Antler removal later will circumvent the risk of, for which we are not responsible, pedicle skin die back. Unless we are advised that stags are to leave Tower Farms with their antlers on, the velvet will be removed the day after the sale, and retained by Tower Farms. All animals are to be transported before Christmas. Note Sue Douglas will organise all transport.
- 10. Should a stag prove to be infertile from natural causes it will be replaced or a full credit given to use at a subsequent Tower Farms Deer Stag Sale, in this situation the stag in question is to be returned to the vendor. In all events the seller will not be held responsible for loss of production or consequential losses on any animal sold. Notification of any dissatisfaction must be made within 9 months of the date of sale. Subject to these terms, the vendor makes no warranty about any animals sold. We recommend that a back up sire be used especially in the first year of a young stags use.




Bandit


Parker



Parker was a twin out of Watsons dam 98 814. He was sent to the commercial block because as you would expect from a twin he didn't make the minimum sale weight at 2 years. However with time his body weight has caught up and his velvet is a mirror image of his sire Ideal Neil. Given our velvet breeding focus of weight with length and style" Parker is a worthy team member in our sire group. "Personality plus" is our Parker, he regularly camps on his own near the smoko room and talks to you, but conversely he will give a shadow a hell of a thrashing during the roar.





The Pentagon cut 10kg SAP velvet 2018. Of special note The Pentagons grand dam 05 5089 is also the dam of JD.




15 5033



We used 15 5033 as a back up to Jefferson in April when Jefferson got a balanitis, and was removed on the 12th from his mating mob (only six out of 40+ unmated). Dam 06 6043 is an exceptional Madison daughter who passes on her bomb proof temperament and high superior antler strike rate in her offspring. 15 5033 was huge at 2yrs and cut 4.25kgs SAP style velvet with beam of 19/18 and 20/18. 6043 has left us six sire stags now, the most outstanding by Holy Oak who is currently No 2 in the SCI record book.




R3yr Stag 16 6105



A very even and tidy head of velvet in place for 16 6105. Comments at removal were, heavy long and strong brows, good medium bezs, two basals, good length trezs, and top tyne placement, the beam above the trezs is taking on a trumpet shape.






This stag we guess will cut over 6kgs of velvet by looking at his beam size. While only at the trezs, his bottom tynes are good medium size and length, with nice black beam to the trezs. Great grandam 9106 was the dam of X Factor, one of our past velvet Sires. Dam 07 7020 has had two other sons make auctions Lot 13 Jan 2013 and Lot 16 2017 making \$8,000 and \$7,500 respectively.




R3yr Stag 16 6011



One of the first crosses to come to auction with Grafanarkis on the bottom line. Removal comments were big, strong, straight brows, both bezs higher, thick trezs, left bifurcating, way long beam, cut early at 16 and 17cm above the trez. Beam stats of 23/23 and 23/23.






There is 26 lines of progeny data to choose from, in the bottom line, the most 'GLITZY' line is great grandam 05 5005 sold to Mt Cecil in 2015 for \$1100 producing Lennix (Rockvale) 1, 2, 3 and 4 year HA champion, for the last 3 years, 05 5005 is still being embryoed, to maybe produce another Lennix, who should he stay alive, may surpass his sires Leon found dead 929 SCI world record. 16 6198s head shows very long and strong brow, bez and trez at cutting stage. Promising.




R3yr Stag 16 6063



Stag 16 6063 is the only offspring from dam 13 3155 who is now owned by Criffel Park. While missing his grandams identification, like us with Rembrarnts missing mum, does it matter, if he leaves behind what he displays himself. Heavy brow, bez and trez, wide V shaped aspect, heavy long trezs, beam thickens dramatically to EXCEPTIONALLY large heavy bulb not yet burst.




R5yr Stag 14 4024 The Pentagon



The Pentagon is a full brother to 3yr stag 16 685 who cut a perfect head of 6.9kg of SAP velvet this year, as was The Pentagons 3yr head of 7.21kg SAP velvet, placing him second in the NIVC 2017. The Pentagon comes from an illustrious hind base that had three 3yr stags sell last year for a total of \$175,000 cutting 9.85kg, 9.65kg and 8.5kgs of SAP velvet. While the dollars are always welcome, the MOST SIGNIFICANT factor is the HIGH STRIKE RATE and REPEATABILITY of this family.




R3yr Stag 16 695



Exceptional progeny data here to support this stag. Dam 10 208 produced the top priced stag in our Dec 2015 stag sale cutting 6.9kg of velvet making \$28,000. 16 695 cut 4.95kg of velvet at 2yrs and hails from the bottom line family of 07 7040 (Grafanarkis' dams sister) who dominated our 2018 3yr velvet sire stags, Brax (15 5090) - 9.85kg \$45,000, 15 5131 - 8.5kg \$65,000, 15 5129 - 9.65kg \$65,000. 16 695 can be staunch on his own.






Stag 16 690 is the third son from dam 09 9030, her first son sold Dec 2017 for \$10,000 cutting 7kg of velvet. Great grandam 99 920 is the dam of 'Fats' that we sold to the late Brian Wellington and now used successfully at Ruperts in Geraldine. 16 690s average beam size is 24cm, we cut him at only 16 and 17cm above the trez.




R3yr Stag 16 634



Stag 16 634 is the first and only son from dam 11 1036 who is now owned by Nick Cranston. This stag is very very impressive so far, the head is wide, very long brow and bez tynes, double right trez, bifurcating left trez, with good distance to two big bunches of royals about to split.






At pen time it looks like this stag trophy wise may really RIP YOUR UNDIES, the only son and offspring from dam 13 3058 now owned by James Hudson. Early head comments were.... heavy heavy brow and bez tynes, heavy fat black beam to heavy long trezs, which are bifurcating and trifurcating, large heavy dropper off left trez, long beam to humongous royal mass.




R3yr Stag 16 686



16 686 is the third son from dam 12 203, her second son featured in our 2018 stag catalogue cutting 7.15kg of velvet, we withdrew him as he split a trez tyne and spoilt our Grafanarkis SAP line up. 16 686s head this year had a very flat aspect, removal comments were, strong and long up turning brows and bezs, good length to heavy trezs, long succulent round beam to cut zone.






16 687 cut 4.6kgs of velvet at 2yrs, comments at velvet removal this year were Big Fat and Black, huge base 32cm coronets, very strong tynes and beam, two basals. 16 687 is the first son from dam 12 2114, who has had two other hind offspring and a weaner stag.




R3yr Stag 16 633



This stag is very late in antler development at 20th Nov pen time, his head is just passed the trezs, but has very heavy and strong brow, bez and trez tynes with a heavy beam. One to watch, especially as it is one of the ever reliable Fig Jam x Discombe/Holy Oak or Discombe x Fig Jam crosses which history shows to excel in great trophy stags.






Out of first fawner 16 6068 is the only male offspring from dam 14 4165, who has left us two hinds since. His head displays straight brows, upturning bezs, good trezs with droppers off each, and like most of his brothers a big Bandit royal ready to burst.





Stag 16 685 is a full brother to 'The Pentagon" one of our resident sires cutting 11kg at 5yrs. 16 685 cut 4.1kg of velvet at 2yrs and 6.9kg of perfectly symmetrical velvet this year with beam stats of 22/22, 22/21. Dam 07 7016 has produced The Pentagon, Lot 21 Dec 2015 \$7000 and another sale contender Lot 42 Aug 2019, a hind making \$9000.






Stag 16 6089 is a half brother to Brax (Lot 6 Dec 2019, cutting 9.85kg and making \$45,000). This stag is a tall unit, he had a toe nail issue around the trez growing stage, which I over trimmed and he was sore for sometime. Grandam 09 9175 is a full sister to the dam of 3yr stag 15 5129 who cut 9.65kgs of velvet last year and sold privately for \$65,000. Great grandam 07 7040s 3yr son 15 5131 cut 8.5kgs last year, also making \$65,000.




R3yr Stag 16 6106



Stag 16 6106 is an embryo brother to 16 640. Like his brother his head is tracking very wide, one birds beak brow, all other three lower tynes strong and long, good length between bez and trez, left trez has three points off it, then onto a front back royal split.






Stag 16 6093 is the only male offspring from 12 2014. His early head comments are, heavy long straight brows, heavy long upright bezs, very good length trezs with good distance between the tynes, with huge Bandit royals on the way.




R3yr Stag 16 669



Stag 16 669 cut beautiful 'fat n black' velvet with beam stats of 22/22 and 24/21, removal comments were huge base, very strong brows, left bez lighter, fat black beam, one side early, one side late, or high trez, low trez.






R3yr Stag 16 6083



3yr stag 16 6083 is the only offspring we have from dam 14 4222 who is now owned by Mt Cecil. His head showed on 20th Nov that it was a heavy head going wide, the lower tynes were good medium brow and bez, heavy beam just at the trezs, looks like droppers to come off each.






Stag 16 638 is the only male offspring from dam 12 264, she also has a R1yr stag on farm by Trump. At pen time 20th Nov, 16 638s head had a very flat aspect, strong up turning brows and bezs, bifurcating left trez with two rows of Fig Jam royals about to start.




R3yr Stag 16 6516



This stag cut a very long scopey Thomas Albert style head, the aspect was extremely wide. The Warnham pedigree reflects the contribution of 040 topline (sister to the dam of Walton) and 634 bottom line (full sister to Murchison), the head displayed one strait D.P.B, very strong bez and trez, with long length between the bez and trez, and long to flattish royal. 




16 600 is the second son from 11 1103, her first selling Dec 2018, Lot 10 for \$15,000 to Nick Cranston.



Duel purpose hind for both velvet and trophy. Dam 11 1039 is a half sister to the dam of sire Beauden.



Great mix of velvet genetics from Altrive, Echo Park and Tower Farms in this pedigree with velvet champions scattered all through out.





Powerful line up of heavy weight velvet genetics with Grafanarkis, Buller, Shock'nor and Watson.












A double shot of Fig Jam in this pedigree should ensure 18 833s offspring have an abundance of width and points. Dam 13 3256s only daughter to date.








Good combination of width, length and points in this trophy pedigree. Dam 10 480 has produced all daughters since her purchase in 2012.








The Pentagon over an unknown Tower Farms hind.







Klein over a first fawning Parker daughter, which is a half sister to our super sire Grafanarkis.


